

Why Do We Do That?

Ever wonder what the words, gestures, and rituals of Mass are all about? Keep an eye on this space each week! This week's question:

Q. Why are the Eucharistic vessels washed during Mass, right after communion?

A. When Communion has been distributed, the vessels are returned to the altar, and there is the practical necessity of clearing up. Naturally the



first concern is for the remains of the Sacred Species. The remaining small Hosts are collected into one ciborium, which is veiled and returned to the tabernacle. All attention should be on the priest who is doing this, and all in the sanctuary kneel until the doors of the tabernacle have closed, for this is Jesus Christ himself passing from our sight, just as he did at the Ascension.

If Communion has been distributed under both kinds, the Precious Blood remaining in the chalices must be consumed. The paten, ciborium, and chalice must then be cleansed. Tiny particles of the Sacred Host and drops of the Precious Blood remain, and must be consumed. Traditionally, a chalice is rinsed twice, both rinsings, or ablutions, being drunk by the priest.

The ablutions are practical and necessary but also symbolic. They are also known as the purifications, in a curious reversal of normal usage that the Church delights in. The sacred vessels have been holding the Body and Blood of our Lord; they have therefore become holy, taken out of ordinary use and made over to God, and cannot come into contact with anything secular. To bring them down to earth as it were, to make it possible to polish them, wrap them up and put them away, they must be ritually "purified." It is not that they are not pure but rather the opposite; they are too holy to touch and need to be brought into the common world again.
