Throughout the New Testament we hear of many amazing things that Jesus did, but out of all the miracles perhaps the greatest of all was teaching in a way that those around him could relate to. Words can create a barrier between us, if we allow them to. Jesus understood that in order to reach a crowd of people he needed to speak at their level—any good speaker understands that if the message is not getting through to the listener than communication is not happening.

Upon hearing the story of the two boys, which of us would not choose the latter of the two as the one who did not follow what his father asked him? The first son was very head strong, yes, but in the end he did choose to do his father's will. Without knowing it, *those around Jesus condemned their own actions with their answer*. Those who prided themselves on their righteousness and piety, the ones who looked down on others, got a little slice of humble pie. *Score one point for Jesus!* You see, there were others in society, whose real-life situations prevented them from being able to strictly adhere to the various Laws, and were STILL going to inherit the Kingdom of Heaven because of their openness to the message.

What do we take from this? Perhaps, let's not talk the talk, let's also walk the walk. Even when we feel we are doing everything we can, we still can fall from grace—while others reform their lives and jump in line.

There is a theme this weekend—a **commitment to community**. Paul expresses that to be a disciple, a follower of Christ, we must live the way Christ instructed us to live. One part of that is to live with humility and not boasting of ourselves. The other part of that instruction was to be in community, to learn and to teach one another, to live in communion just as our Triune God lives. **What a perfect weekend for this reading!** A weekend where we have the opportunity to come together and celebrate the life that God has gifted each of us. A chance for the world, or at least Oshkosh, to see that we are an active and vibrant group of followers of Jesus right here at St. Jude Parish!

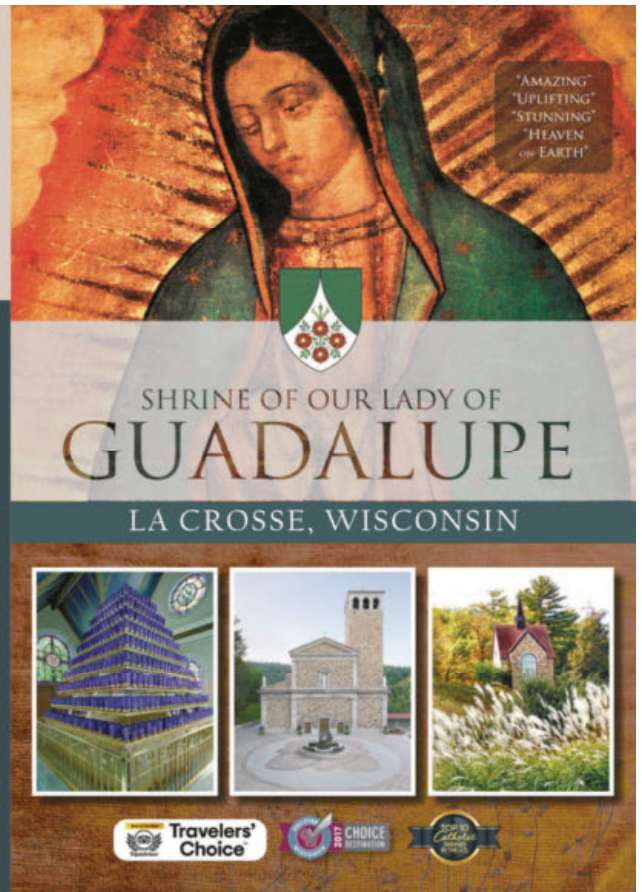

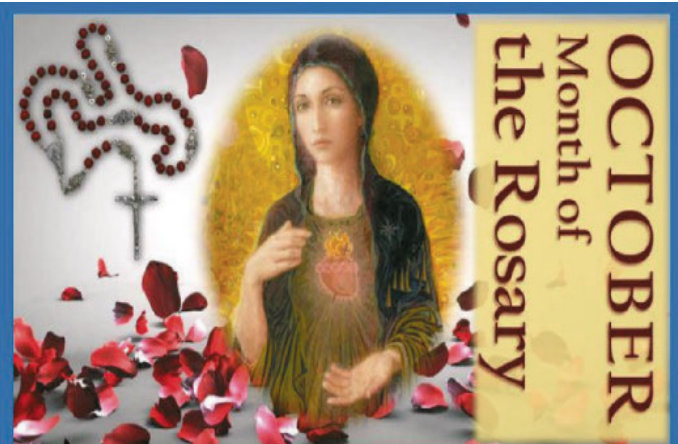

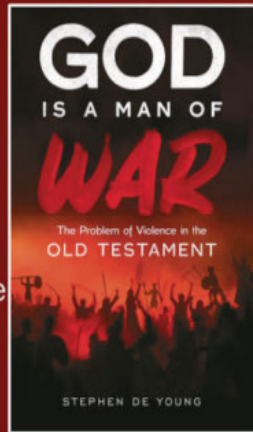
**God Is a Man of War:

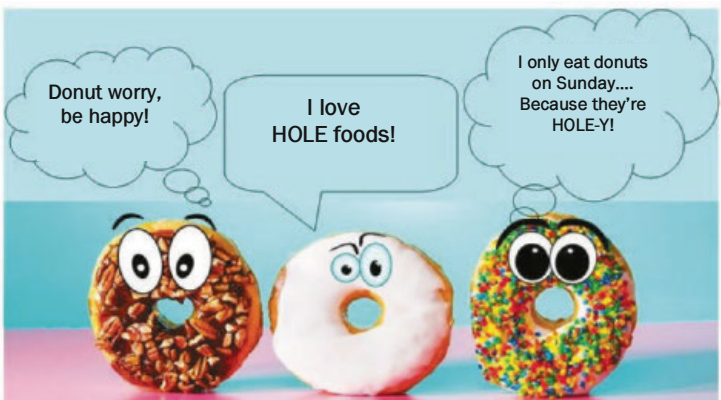

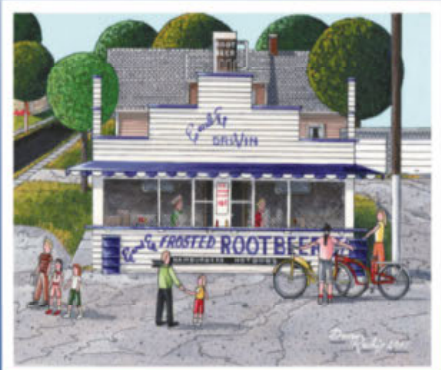

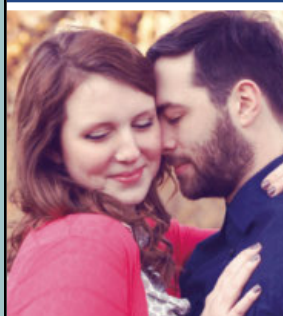
