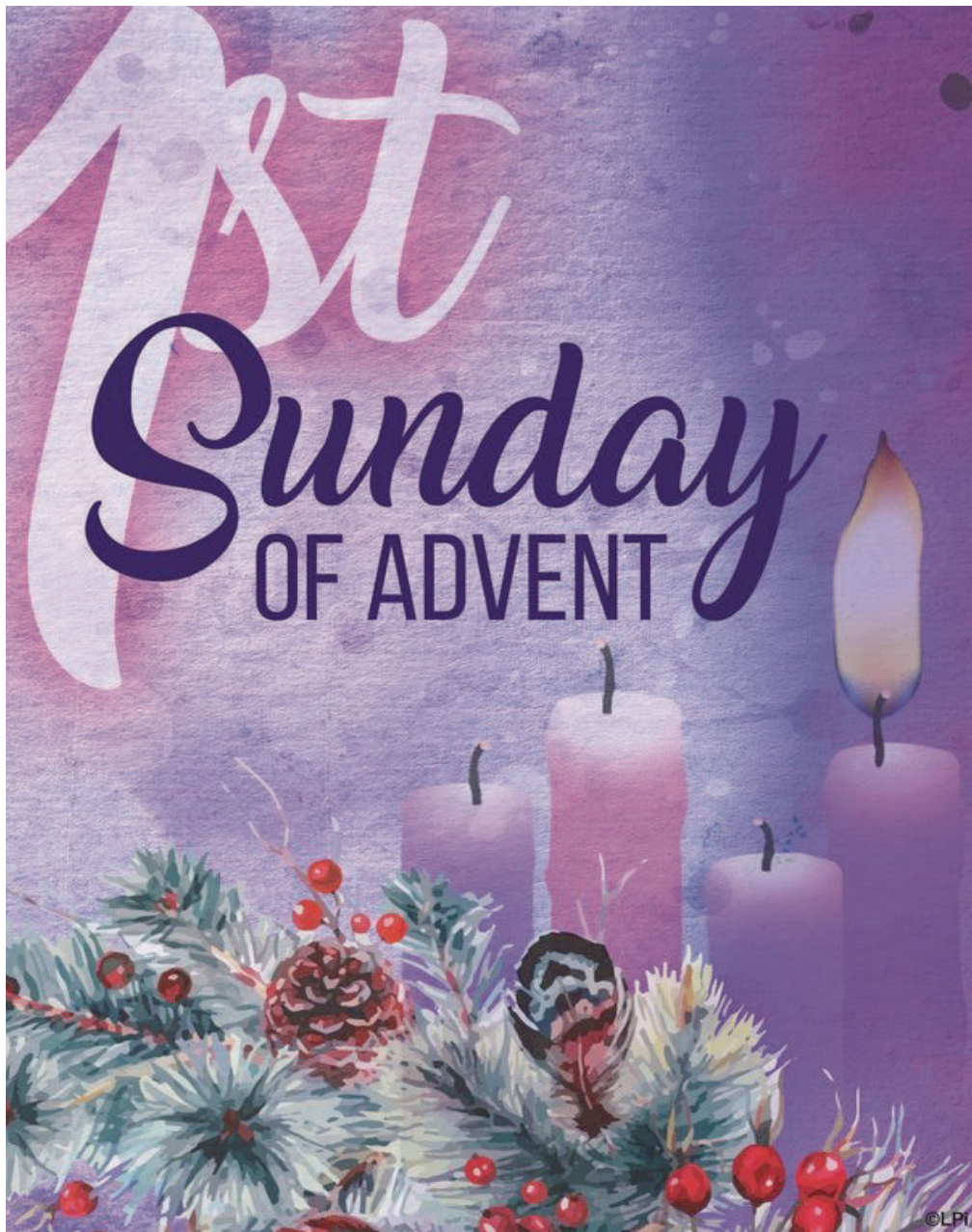

Anticipation! It is a song written and sung by Carly Simon. She sings about waiting for a love to show her how much he cares. Today is the first Sunday of Advent and we too feel anticipation as we wait for our Love to show us how much He cares also! We are waiting to celebrate the birth of Christ. The greatest love of all. I love this season of Advent and feel bad that it is so brushed over. We seem to jump from Thanksgiving (and lately even right from Halloween) right to Christmas. We hurry so much that we miss the great anticipation of Advent. I like to imagine the anticipation of Mary at this time; awaiting the arrival of her son. The joy, the fear and the wondering that all expectant mothers feel, yet with the added wonder of knowing who her son really is! It is this time of year where we as adults can join in the wonder of childhood. Look at the face of a child who is anticipating Christmas. It is full of wonder and delight. Granted, they are anticipating gifts from Santa, but they also find delight in the lights, the snow, the cookies and just about every aspect of the season. It is up to us to express this same delight in the coming of Christ.

Lighting the first candle on the Advent wreath, saying a special little prayer each day as part of our "count down" to Christmas., reading the story of Mary and Joseph's journey. Showing our own anticipation by celebrating the season of Advent in our homes as well as at Church is how we teach our little ones about the true love of Christmas. Each candle lit brings us one week closer to the biggest birthday party ever! All children will understand that.

When I was a child, we celebrated Advent in our house. We lit candles, had an Advent calendar and talked about the Holy Family. On Christmas Eve we went to Mass and when we came home we found a decorated Christmas tree with presents underneath! That tree had not been there when we left—how did that happen? We never saw a lit tree in our house before Christmas Eve. Talk about anticipation! Then before gifts for us it was "Happy Birthday Jesus!"

These are some of my warmest and most cherished memories. Lets try to not skip over Advent this year. Oh, I don't mean you should wait for Christmas Eve to light your tree (unless you want to) but try to incorporate some Advent traditions into your Holiday. As a family, try to build up to Christmas and the celebration of the greatest gift of all—our Lord being born as a human baby to experience all of our joys and sorrows in order to free us of our sins and show us how to achieve eternal life in heaven. That is the true meaning of love . I know it fills me with ANTICIPATION!

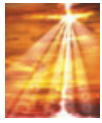
