## *Make room for mercy as we enter into Lent!*

The Gospel reading helps us to see Jesus' mercy in the miracle he performed, and in his command to follow the teachings of the time, sending the healed man back to the priests. This weekend we begin to head into a time of Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving, how can we open ourselves up to the Holy Spirit? Can we look at our own lives and see where our own personal leprosy, is so that we can go to our Father that loves us and be cleansed? Have we taken account of our daily lives and gone humbly to Jesus to ask for his healing? We might not have experienced the isolation and alienation from entire social and religious communities like the lepers in Jesus' day, but our Sin does serve to isolate us. There is a saying along the lines of *God multiplies and the Devil divides*. Jesus defeated the devil in His Death and Resurrection. We are all then worthy and able to receive that Mercy which wipes away our sin, allowing us to return to God! Pray that the Holy Spirit helps you to get out of your own way and come back to your community. God our loving Father is waiting for you to come back to him, no matter the stain of sin, he pours out His love Just For YOU!

We are approaching the season of Lent which begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14th. On that same day we also celebrate the Feast of St. Valentine, otherwise known as Valentine's Day in our secular world. This upcoming week is quite busy! *I would encourage everyone to make room for the sacrament of reconciliation* as we enter into Lent. This amazing sacrament truly heals those wounds and hurts that nothing from this physical world can.

*Come and pray as part of our Parish community.* Jesus gave us the model that prayer is meant to be shared and lived together. Here at St. Jude we will have the opportunity, again, to pray **Stations of the**

**Cross** as a faith community twice a week throughout Lent. Tuesdays at 5:30 pm, Sacred Heart Church and Fridays at 12:15 pm, St. Vincent Church. Not only is it an opportunity to pray together but also to share a meal as both times are followed by a potluck style soup meal. **This is a great way to enjoy warm fellowship and hot soup!** Do you have an amazing soup or bread that you would like to share with the parish? Stop by the Parish Office, or call, and sign up for a date that works for you! Fear not if you aren't the chef in the family, all are welcome and free will offers are accepted.

Offer up your almsgiving by joining our Religious Education classes as they compete in the annual **Lenten Penny Wars**. Containers will be located in the back of each church by grade level, middle school being grades 6th - 8th, and high school grades 9th - 11th. Coins other than pennies subtract from the grades score, while pennies and any bills add to a grades score. Add lots of silver coins to an opposing grades jar to help out your grade or add those bills to really stack up the score :)

Beyond the fun of pocket change and loose bills - we have decided to participate in a **Cross Catholic Outreach** Lenten Program, **Wells of Salvation**. See the next page for more details! We don't have to buy a plane ticket and become missionaries on the other side of the world, we can join our fellow Catholics that are there with our almsgiving to help fund their works.

In these final days before Lent, reflect on where you can ask humbly for forgiveness and allow more room for Jesus.

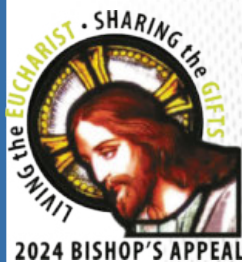

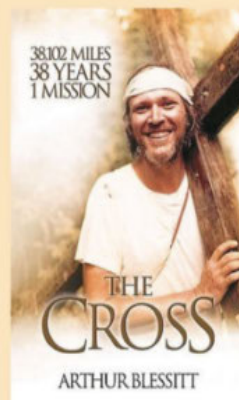
