

Humbled

Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!

We have arrived at Palm Sunday, a time we recall Jesus riding into Jerusalem with joy and celebration. Imagine yourself for a moment in this very familiar scene. Is the sun shining brightly, the air dry and hot or is there a crisp breeze blowing? Are you alone or shoulder to shoulder with your family? Listen to all the sounds, the cacophony of voices raised in cheering. Notice the way the sun filters through the palm branches as they are waved back and forth all around you. The dust and dirt from the roads being kicked up in the commotion of people celebrating. What smells are there in the crowd; is it the sweet of perfume and fragrant flowers or does it stir up smells of dirt and body odor? As the crowd grows louder and louder, moving in closer and closer, you lift your eyes and see Jesus atop the colt. Jesus Christ is Lord!



Our God loves us so much He **humbled** himself into the lowly form of a human so that we might know His love! Jesus emptied himself out for us, He models how to be truly obedient to the Father's will. Jesus in His divinity could have asked the Father to save him from what was to come but instead He faced every human condition so that we might return to the Father.


