

#### **BAPTISM**

A pre-baptismal class is required for all parents. Baptism preparation classes are held on the second Tuesday of the month for 1st time parents and on the third

Tuesday of the month for parents baptizing their second, third...child. Class must be completed 4-6 weeks before the date of the baptism.

Parents are welcome to take the class before their baby is born also. Call the parish office for available dates and to register.

#### Dearly beloved in the Risen Lord,

With great joy in my heart I announce to you: "Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!" This ancient greeting sums up what we celebrate this Easter Sunday, the joy of Christ risen and alive in our midst. "This is the day the Lord has made: let us rejoice and be glad" (Psalm 118). This then is the Joyful Good News: Christ by his death and resurrection has conquered sin so we may live. The Resurrection is the foundation and cornerstone of our faith. As St. Paul says if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is useless, and our faith too is in vain (Cf. 1 Cor 15:14).

On Easter Vigil we recall God's story – in our story of salvation. The liturgy of the Word re-presents that story, and we joyfully celebrate the risen Lord in our midst as He offers Himself anew in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. We do this in a spirit of thanksgiving to God who gives His own Son to die in order to rescue us from the slavery of sin. May we live as people deeply touched by the resurrection and proclaim: Christ is risen, Alleluia! May our encounter with the risen Lord on our journey of faith touch us deeply and transform us as He did for His Disciples. May the resurrection lead us to be the best version of ourselves; committed to live out our Baptismal promises.

When we live the new life of the resurrection we become the best version of ourselves. We become what St Augustine referred to as an "Easter People", a people transformed into disciples and stewards who commit to give their time, talent and treasure in witness. My prayer for you this Easter is that you live as people deeply touched by the resurrection and proclaim, Christ is risen, Alleluia, Alleluia!

This Easter, I invite us to rediscover the symbol and power of our faith as a light which can dispel the darkness that we presently experience. As an Easter people, let us proclaim the Resurrected Christ knowing that He has brought forth life from death, light from darkness, and hope from despair. As Saint John Paul II says, "Do not abandon yourselves to despair. We are the Easter people and hallelujah is our song." And so, let us find within our faith the sustenance and resolve to proclaim, "He is risen." And we rejoice saying, "Alleluia. Alleluia. Alleluia." May God bless you with abundant faith, serenity and joy of Easter.


