

## SACRED HEART SCHOOL BUILDING WALK-THRU

We are pleased to inform you that the Diocese has approved the proxy for the deconstruction of the Sacred School building. The second and final walk-through of the Sacred Heart School Building, a significant event that provides a unique opportunity for our community to bid farewell to the building, has been scheduled for **Thursday, September 5, between 6 pm and 7 pm**. For safety reasons, there will be no entrance into the basement or attic spaces of the building. Please note that once the building is officially entrusted to American Relics, LLC., St. Jude Parish will no longer have access to the inside of the building due to liability issues.

As this significant transition unfolds, we are deeply grateful to those who constructed the building, those who maintained its functionality for so long, and those who will ensure that the building's history lives on in our Parish and the surrounding communities. We acknowledge the heartache of this moment, but we are also excited about the new possibilities. Some items from the building will be repurposed in the new Adoration Chapel, a symbol of hope, with a tentative completion in October of 2025 (God willing!).

In the near future, there will be information in the bulletin about the timeline of events, opportunities to view the conceptual drawings of the Adoration Chapel, and other pertinent information. We are deeply grateful for your support and prayers as we continue to move forward with this project. Your prayers are a source of strength and encouragement, and they proclaim to those around us that the Catholic Church is alive and well in Oshkosh!

Guess what? A new school year is beginning. Lots of parents will be very happy, while summertime baby-sitting grandparents will be divided between those who say, "Thank Heaven!" and those who will really miss the company and the excitement of having little ones around.

Being a retired teacher, I have a list of hopes for the coming school year:

- 1. That every student will be matched with a teacher or teachers who are best-suited for that student's personality and learning style.



## World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation

The first day of September is celebrated by Christians around the world as the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. It also marks the beginning of the Season of Creation, which will conclude on the Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi, October 4.

In 2015, Pope Francis in addition to his landmark encyclical Laudato Si', wrote a letter instituting the observance of World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation in the Catholic Church.

The Season of Creation is an optional liturgical celebration in the Church. In his message for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation 2024, Pope Francis reminds us how the Holy Spirit "keeps the believing community alert and calls it to conversion in lifestyles, to resist human degradation of the environment." As individuals there are ways we can respond to Pope Francis' call to care for creation. Here are a few ideas:

- Avoid a disposable mindset/refuse to be part of the "throwaway culture".
- Spend time in nature/visit the Reflection Garden on the parish center grounds.
- Join discussions about conservation and care for the environment
- Look at creation with wonder and awe and give thanks to God.
