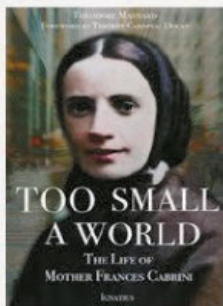
This means that no one is to enter the building. The staff in the St. Jude office are also not able to access or enter.

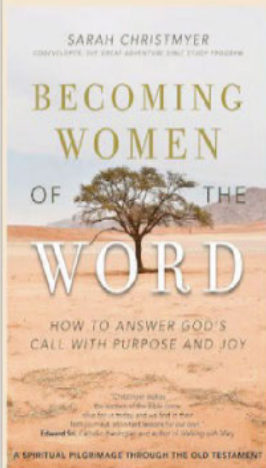

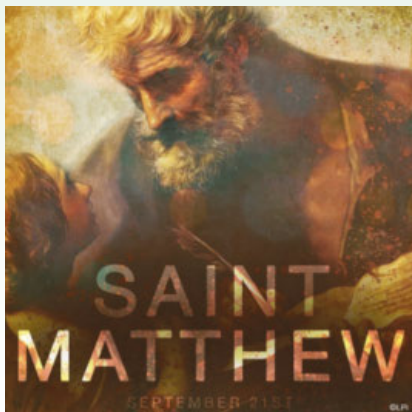
