

Please call the parish office.


PARISH REGISTRATION

We will begin taking Mass Intentions for the year 2025 starting on **Monday, October 14.** Here's a refresher on some of the rules:

- We have a limit of 3 Masses per person per year (ex: 3 for Mom, 3 for Dad)
- We are unable to accept a Mass Intention under the heading of *special intention*, we need to have a name or reason for the Mass
- We have one Mass set each weekend as a Collective Mass, if you wish to name 4 or more people in your intention it will need to be scheduled during one of the Collective Masses. The Collective Masses are offered at different times, but are preset and cannot be moved.


