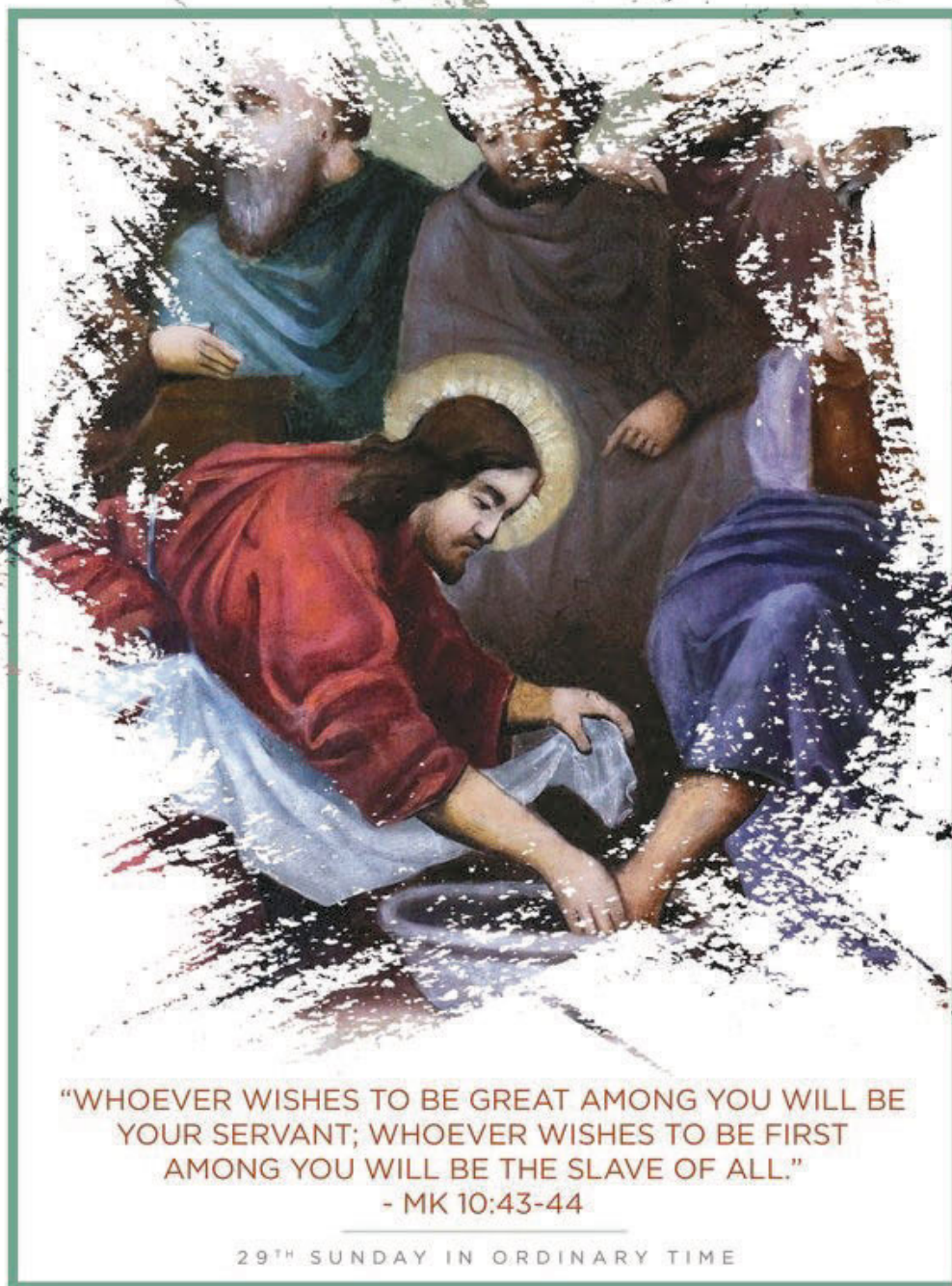

ST. JUDE NOVENA: OCTOBER 20–28

Pray the St. Jude novena prayer daily starting October 20, leading up to the Feast of St. Jude on October 28!

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, ✠ and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Most holy St. Jude—apostle, martyr, and friend of Jesus—today I ask that you pray for me and my intentions!

(State your intentions here.)

You are the patron of the impossible. O St. Jude, pray that God's grace and mercy will cover my intentions. Pray for the impossible if it is God's will. Pray that I may have the grace to accept God's holy will even if it is painful and difficult for me.

(Pray the petition of the day:)

Day 1, October 20: St. Jude, you loved our Lord, help me to love Him more.

Day 2, October 21: St. Jude, pray that I may have your zeal to preach the Gospel.

Day 3, October 22: St. Jude, you labored for years, pray that I may have patience in my struggles.

Day 4, October 23: St. Jude, you are known for answering lost causes, pray for my most impossible needs.

Day 5, October 24: St. Jude, you sacrificed for the Kingdom of God, pray that I may sacrifice like you.

Day 6, October 25: St. Jude, pray that I may know God's will in my life.

Day 7, October 26: St. Jude, pray that I may put my trust in God, confident that He knows my needs even better than I do and that He provides.

Day 8, October 27: St. Jude, pray for me, that I will not lose hope.

Day 9, October 28, Feast of St. Jude: St. Jude, pray for me, that I will not lose faith.

O St. Jude, pray for me that I may grow in faith, hope, and love, and in the grace of Jesus Christ. Pray for my intentions, but most of all pray that I may join you in heaven with God for all eternity. Amen.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, ✠ and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

A novena (from "novem," Latin for "nine") is nine days of prayer and meditation, often offered for a particular intention. Jesus told his disciples to pray together after his ascension into heaven, so they went to an upper room along with the Blessed Virgin Mary, and prayed for nine days leading up to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. This pattern of nine days of prayer is the basis of the novenas we pray today.

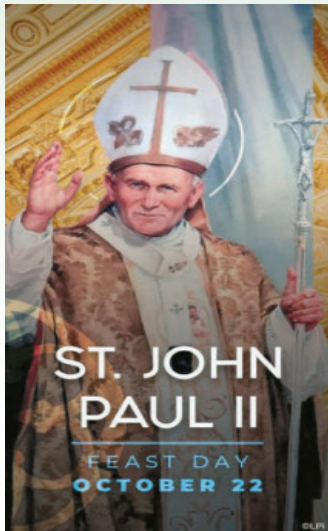
