27th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings for the 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B offer important lessons about marriage, family, and living as children of God. These reflections explore the themes of unity, respect, and trust found in the scriptures. They invite us to understand and live out these teachings in our daily lives.

Unity in Marriage

In the reading from Genesis, God declares the things he created “good”. Until he gets to man being by himself. That is “not good”. So God creates woman as a partner for man, showing that marriage is meant to be a union of equals. God says, “It is not good for the man to be alone.” He creates woman from man’s rib, symbolizing that they are of the same flesh and meant to support each other.

This union is blessed by God and highlights the importance of companionship. Marriage is a sacred bond that calls for mutual respect and love. It is a partnership where both husband and wife work together to build a family and support each other in all aspects of life. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches that what God has joined together, no one should separate. This reinforces the idea that marriage is a lifelong commitment. This year marks the 45th Anniversary of St. Francis of Assisi being named the patron saint of those who promote ecology. This year is also, the 800th anniversary of the Stigmata of St. Francis.

St. Francis is one of the most venerated religious figures in Roman Catholic history. He is best known for his profound connection to nature, dedication to humility and for his steadfast commitment to serve the poor.

Here are a few more facts about St. Francis that you might not know:

1. His original name was John, after John the Baptist.
2. He was the first recorded person to receive the stigmata.
3. Before his conversion, Francis led a life of partying and frivolity.
4. Pope Innocent III approved the rule of Francis and the founding of the Franciscan order after he had a dream that a small man was holding up the Lateran basilica which was about to fall down. The pope saw Francis as that man and stated “he is the one who will hold up Christ’s Church by what he does and what he teaches.”
5. It is said that birds flew away in the shape of a cross after Francis spoke to them.
