

Henny Youngman was a comedian who was known for his doctor jokes. Here's one of his best.

"A doctor told a man he had six months to live; but the man couldn't pay his bill.

So the doctor agreed to give him another six months to live!"

While the joke is funny, it does beg the question, how long does each of us have to live? How much more time do we

have to make a difference in the world? Or, maybe the better question is, how much time do we have to make a difference within ourselves—to prepare for when we come face to face with God?




