Henny Youngman was a comedian who was known for his doctor jokes. Here's one of his best.

"A doctor told a man he had six months to live; but the man couldn't pay his bill. So the doctor agreed to give him another six months to live!"



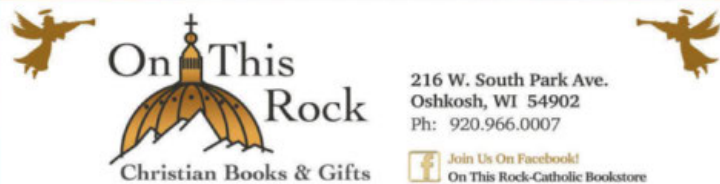
