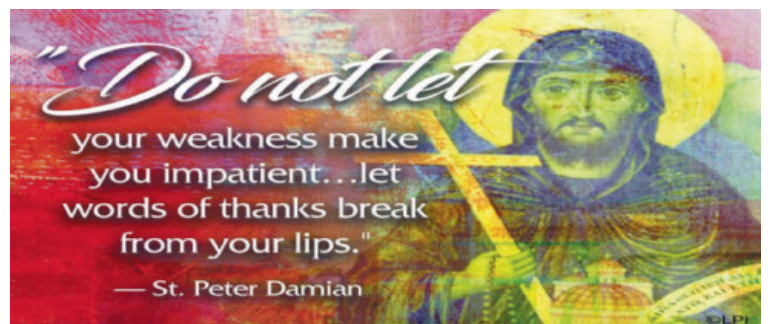

Care for Creation!



St. Jude Parish Crayon Recycling Drive

The Caring for God's Creation Committee and the Religious Education students are excited to introduce a first ever Parish crayon recycling event.

Why:

Millions of crayons are produced in the U.S. daily, and millions of children use them. But did you know that recycling crayons keeps thousands of pounds of waxy sludge out of the landfills because they are made out of a petroleum-based wax that is not biodegradable.

How:

The crayons that are collected will be sent to the **National Crayon Recycling Program (NCRP)** which collects unwanted, broken, or rejected crayons and recycles them into new crayons, which are then distributed to children in need, aiming to reduce waste while bringing joy to kids through art supplies. Essentially, they take old crayons, melt them down, and create new, fun-shaped crayons to give to children facing challenging situations.

When and Where:

The crayon collection drive will start on Ash Wednesday (March 5th) along with the Religious Education students' Lenten Penny Wars. Collection containers will be at each church site as well as the parish center and school.

So, clean out the arts and crafts drawers or playroom, check grandma's stash too, collect the **broken, unused crayons (leave the labels on) and drop them in a collection box.** The Caring for God's Creation Committee will do the rest.

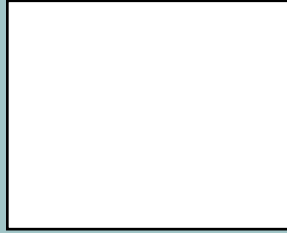
