#### Bertie's Bits

When thinking about when I was growing up, I can so distinctly vision "laundry day" at our house. The smell of soap (my mom always used CHEER Laundry detergent) and bleach. It always had to be a sunny and breezy day, if possible, because of course the clothes were hung on the line. Now this hanging out of clothes was quite an art! Everything had to be hung in a certain way. Uniformity and neatness mattered a lot— at the time I thought perhaps it made the clothes dry faster! But, no, that wasn't why. It was so that the neighbor ladies would see what a good house wife my mother was. Another very important aspect to doing this laundry was to make sure the "whites" were as white as possible (another sign that Mom knew what she was doing!). Now, we all know how hard it can be to keep those whites looking at their best. After all, we spill things or dribble things or wear things to do work that shouldn't be done in white clothes (my dad). What a great feeling to see those stains be washed out and the wrinkles ironed out and that wonderful fresh smell! Like a brand-new piece of material! No matter how many neighbors she impressed— I know that really Mom did it for us out of love and pride in her family.

Lent makes me think of Mom's laundry day. Our Baptism brought us into a clean fresh spirit. Most of us were infants when this occurred and therefore unaware of the graces bestowed on us through the anointing and sprinkling and prayers. We would learn that and so much more in the years to come. Keeping that white clean spirit will not be an easy task. We will sin and cause that soul to become stained. But just like my mom's love for her family, God our Heavenly Father, through his only son, Jesus, and through the Holy Spirit will keep working to clean us up. All we have to do is ask! We must do the scrubbing and hanging and ironing through

prayer, reading scripture, repenting for the stains we cause and asking for forgiveness. Just like the father in today's Gospel, our heavenly Father is always waiting and watching for us to return. He rejoices when we even make baby-steps toward uniting with Him. He knows how hard it is to keep our souls clean and bright. There are so many temptations and trials, and we are weak! But Jesus also knows this and through him and his love and sacrifice we can return home to our Father and be washed clean and bright as new!

This is why our Holy Sacraments are so important. They seal us, cleanse us, and strengthen us for the not so easy cleaning of our dirty laundry. Let's make this Lent one big laundry day, through prayer, fasting and alms-giving. Go to receive reconciliation with our heavenly Father by going to confession. Read scripture to bring you a deeper understanding, go to Mass and receive Eucharist often for sustaining the strength we all need. Don't do it to show the neighbors how dedicated and good you are—do it for yourself and your relationship with God. Oh, and if you slip and eat a piece of that chocolate you gave up-remember Jesus is the best stain remover ever! May the rest of your Lent bring you peace and love beyond all understanding.






