"If they keep quiet the stones will cry out" (Luke 19:40)

In the Gospel before the procession with palms we heard an interesting choice of words for Jesus proclaim to to people. An inanimate object is going to cry out if the people do not—what poetic, startling imagery for us. Do you think that the people around were starring at each other questioning what he meant? I'm curious if anyone with a pet rock was

jumping for joy at that moment excited that they finally hear their may rock speak!

It is not uncommon in the Bible to hear such poetic verbiage. In Isaiah 55:12 we hear "...Mountains and hills shall break out in songs before you, all trees of


the field shall clap their hands." In Psalm 114:4-5 it says "The mountains skipped like rams; the hills, like lambs. Why was it, sea, that you fled?" Perhaps the best one is in Habakkuk 2:11 where it is written "For the stone in the wall will cry out and the beam in the frame shall answer it!" Makes you wonder if those words were foreshadowing something. This language invokes a sense of awe in our minds and gives us a glimpse of the sheer power of our God. All of His creation is able to give Him honor and glory.

Pharisees realized that Today the they had no control over the crowds. In their powerlessness they called upon Jesus to quiet the crowd. Unfortunately for them it is time for the crowd to be encouraged by Jesus to speak up — to raise their voices. No longer is he saying like he did so often before, go and tell no one. The people of Jerusalem are expressing great joy in his arrival, a joy that was necessary-so necessary that if God's human creation was not going to cheer then the inanimate objects


> of the world were going to have to fill the void! The King of kings is entering HIS capital city and Jesus wants the honor he is deserved.

> people As the cheer sounds today the will become less and less as the

week continues. Until Friday, when the piece of timber will be too much for him to bear. Those around will watch and ridicule him as he is nailed to the cross—the cross that will bear salvation of the world. It is on this day that I find our faith the most difficult. Having to yell those words "Crucify him! Crucify him!" brings me to tears. May our words always be for proclaiming His life and never be for tearing another down. Don't make the rocks cry out on our behalf.




